## Domestic Abuse

An estimated **41,000** individuals experience domestic abuse in Birmingham each year

**57%** INCREASE

in reports of domestic abuse to the Police

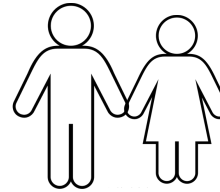
**19%** INCREASE

**1** IN **5** children experience domestic abuse in the home

of all children need support, care or protection from the Local Authority

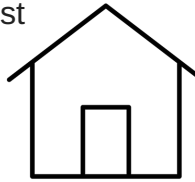


HIGHER THAN ENGLAND AVERAGE

There are **approximately 400 children in temporary accommodation (TA)** due to domestic abuse. Each **can spend approx 300 days (on average) in TA.**

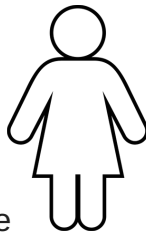

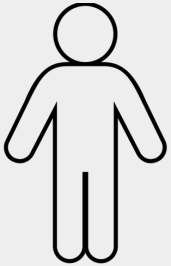

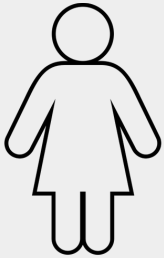

MALE 19+ YRS

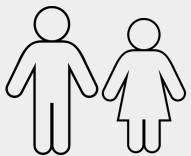
