

Domestic Abuse

An estimated **41,000**

individuals experience domestic abuse in Birmingham each year

57% INCREASE

in reports of domestic abuse to the Police

Children at risk

There are approximately 400 children in temporary accommodation (TA) due to domestic abuse. Each can spend approx 300 days (on average) in TA.
