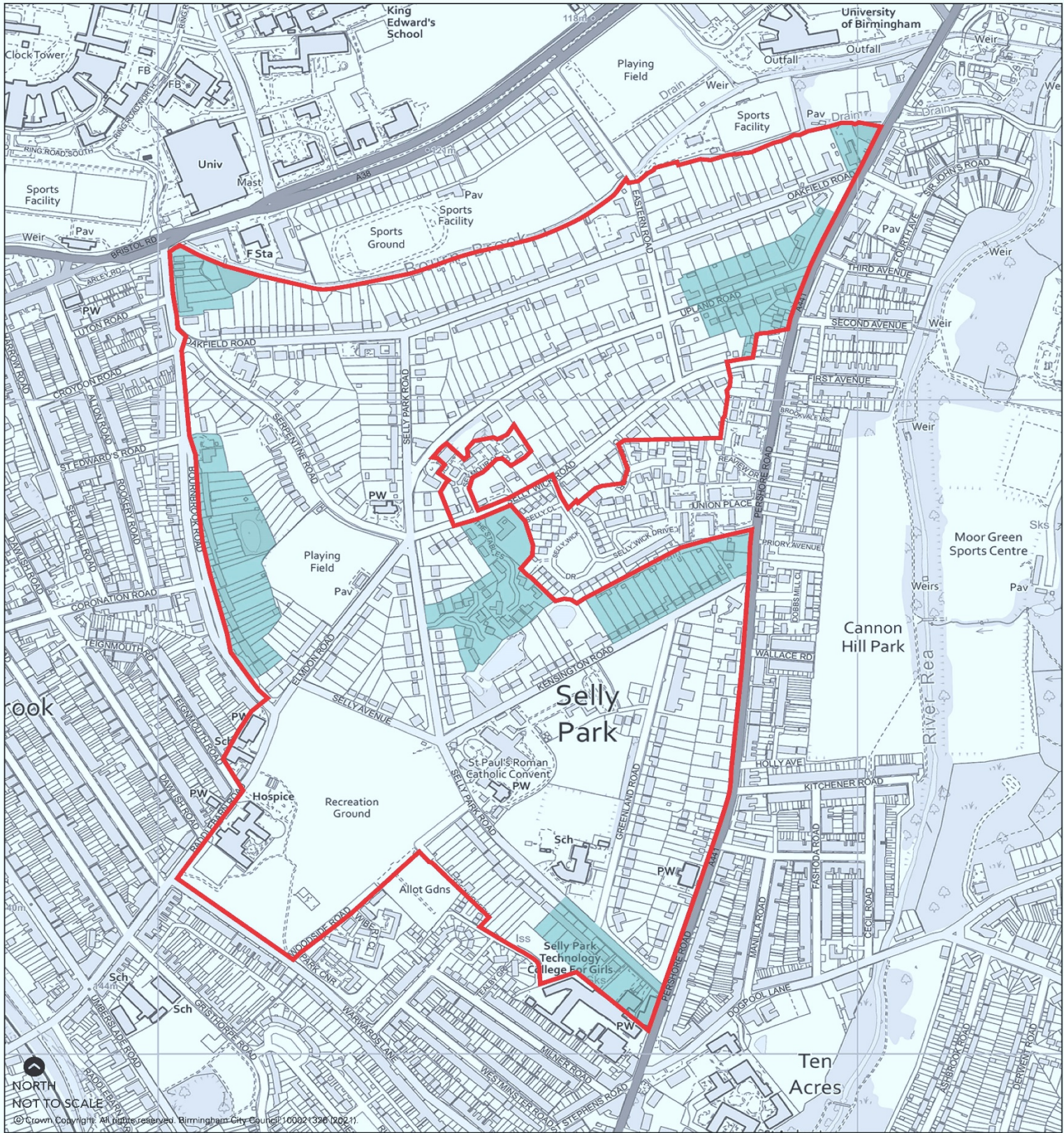


Selly Park CAAMP Boundary Plan 1

Description of boundary

The proposed boundary starts at the western end of Oakfield Road and proceeds North along Bournbrook Road to include numbers 1-15 on the Eastern side of the road. The boundary then turns East to follow the back of the gardens on Oakfield Road following Bournbrook across Eastern Road all the way to the Pershore Road. The boundary turns south down the middle of Pershore Road, the odd number houses on the West are included all the way to 643, here the boundary goes behind 663-667 Pershore Road. The boundary then goes along the back of the gardens on the south of Selly Wick Road all the way to number 35, although number 3 Selly Wick drive and all of Over Mill Drive are not included. The boundary then runs west down the middle of Selly Wick Road as far as Seymour Close where all of the properties are included along with 68 and 70 Selly Wick Road, the boundary then runs back east down the centre of Selly Wick Road as far as Selly Close where the boundary runs down the back of the properties so all of the properties are excluded. All of Selly Wick Drive is excluded, the boundary follows the rear gardens of the properties on the south side of Selly Wick Drive as far as Pershore Road. The boundary then runs south down the centre of Pershore Road, including the properties on the West starting with 763. The boundary then continues south down Pershore Road for 800 metres until its junction with Selly Park Road. The properties on the south of Selly Park Road are included in the boundary which runs along the back gardens as far as 67 Selly Park Road where the boundary turns south and encompasses the recreation ground including St Marys hospice. The boundary runs up the middle of Raddlebarn Road until it reaches St Edward's church and Primary school, here the boundary runs behind these properties, so they are included in the boundary. Just after the church the boundary turns north west along Bournbrook Road, continuing all the way to the junction with Oakfield Road where this boundary description began.
