



Notes :-

1. Normally not more than 2 No. signs and supplementary plates on one post.
2. Never more than three signs but no supplementary plates.
3. When using supplementary plates ensure there is no ambiguity, E.g. 'End.
4. When there is a supplementary plate below a triangular sign, or 2 No. rectangular signs together, they must be separated by a distance equal to the "x" height of the lower sign.
5. Where two warning signs are mounted together the first met hazard should be at the top.
6. This drawing should be read in conjunction with BCC Guide to Siting and Specification of Street Furniture.
7. The post should not protrude more than 50mm above the top sign upon completion of the installation of the sign and post.
