#### 1 Welcome & Introductions

1.1 Chris Tambini welcomed everybody to the meeting.

## 2 Previous Minutes

2.1 Actions in the last meeting covered and minutes of last meeting were agreed as an accurate record.

## 3 Finance Update (Fiona Greenway)

- 3.1 Fiona Greenway presented and reminded the Board that the Council was granted Exceptional Financial Support from Central Government for the current financial year, but this has not been granted for the Financial Year of 2024/25. These funds are not "extra money" but allows the Council to finalise a balanced budget for the year 2023/2024. The access to this Exceptional Financial Support allows the Council to use capital receipts to close the budget gap. For the Financial Year of 2025/2026 there is a budget gap of £143.7 million. £76.3 million of savings have been identified, but this still presents a gap of £67 million and when the pressures for the next Financial Year are reconsidered, this gap is likely to increase as pressures for the Council increases. Savings are being identified as either "priority savings", "medium risk savings" or "low risk savings." All savings will need to be evidenced and there is a tight regime of monitoring these savings.
- 3.2 Commissioners have asked for a balanced budget for the next two Financial Years and the Finance department expect that they will be able to present this to Commissioners for consideration by the end of June 2024.
- 3.3 Chris Tambini noted that the Council are responding to Commissioner's instructions more positively, but the necessary progress is not yet happening at the pace required.

# 4 Equal Pay (Fiona Greenway)

4.1 Fiona Greenway updated the board. The Equal Pay liabilities are the biggest liability owed by the Council currently. New pay structures are being put in place alongside a new Job Evaluation scheme to prevent future liabilities.

# 5 Finance Modernisation (Fiona Greenway)

- 5.1 Fiona Greenway presented. The aim of this item is to rebuild the financial function and address deeprooted problems within the organisation and the Finance directorate, a lot of which will be resolved when Oracle is successfully reimplanted. This process is being accelerated with a focus on Audit and Risk, but Commissioners note that the pace needs to be accelerated further.
- 5.2 The Council need to improve Income and Debt Management. Work is happening surrounding Financial leadership, suppliers and supplier control and contract management. The Council currently outsource the final accounts production to KPMG but would like to become self-sufficient to make savings. Commissioners have requested the work be carried out at a faster pace.
- 5.3 Commissioners request Finance Modernisation be added as a standing item for future meetings
