

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 245

- The path is first recorded on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840, which is held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.
- He path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition (1880's) of the Ordnance Survey 6 inch map.
- Part of the route is shown on the deposited plans for the then proposed Birmingham, Kidderminster and Stoke Railway 1889, where parcei 42 in Northfield is described in the Book of Reference as "Field, Public Footpaths and stream". (These are held by the Warwickshire County Record Office at QS111/452.)
- Part of the route is also shown on the deposited plans for the then proposed Birmingham, Kidderminster and Stourport Railway 1892, where parcel 36 in Northfield is described in the Book of Reference as "Field and footpath", with the owners including the Northfield Highway Board. (These documents are held by the Warwickshire County Record Office at QS111/471.)
- The north-west end of the path was diverted onto proposed new streets, with the creation of a short link south-west from the south-west end of Cornmill Close, and another link from Middle Acre Road south-west to Mill Lane, by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order with a Certificate of Completion dated 27 May 1955, from a Sessions held on 24 September 1951. (The Order is held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library at QS/B/21/5 (Box 18, item 2).)
- The middle section of the path was diverted by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order to go along the estate roads (including Bickington Road), with a Certificate of Completion dated 26 November 1857, from a Sessions held on 24 September 1951. (The Order is held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library at QS/B/21/5 (Box 18, item 3).)
- 7 The path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the Ordnance Survey 1/25,000 sheet SP08 (published 1952, with revisions 1970), with the north-east end being shown as a track.
- The north-east end is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
