

#### Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 203

- The path is first shown on the first edition (1880's) of the Ordnance Survey 6 inch map.
- The path was diverted by A quarter Sessions Highways Order to form two passages either side of Glyn Farm Road, the Certificate of Completion being dated 14 June 1939, from a Sessions held on 1 October 1934. (The Order is held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library at QS/B/21/1 (Box 14, Bundle 1, item 12).)
- The Birmingham A-Z Street Map shows passages either side of Glyn Farm Road, while the Ordnance Survey 'Explorer' sheet 220 shows the northern one with a dog-leg in it.
- Both sections of the path have 'no cycling' notices at their ends, with modern street lighting and a tarmac surface.
- The paths are recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way, although in a straight line.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the two sections of path subsist as public footpaths and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
