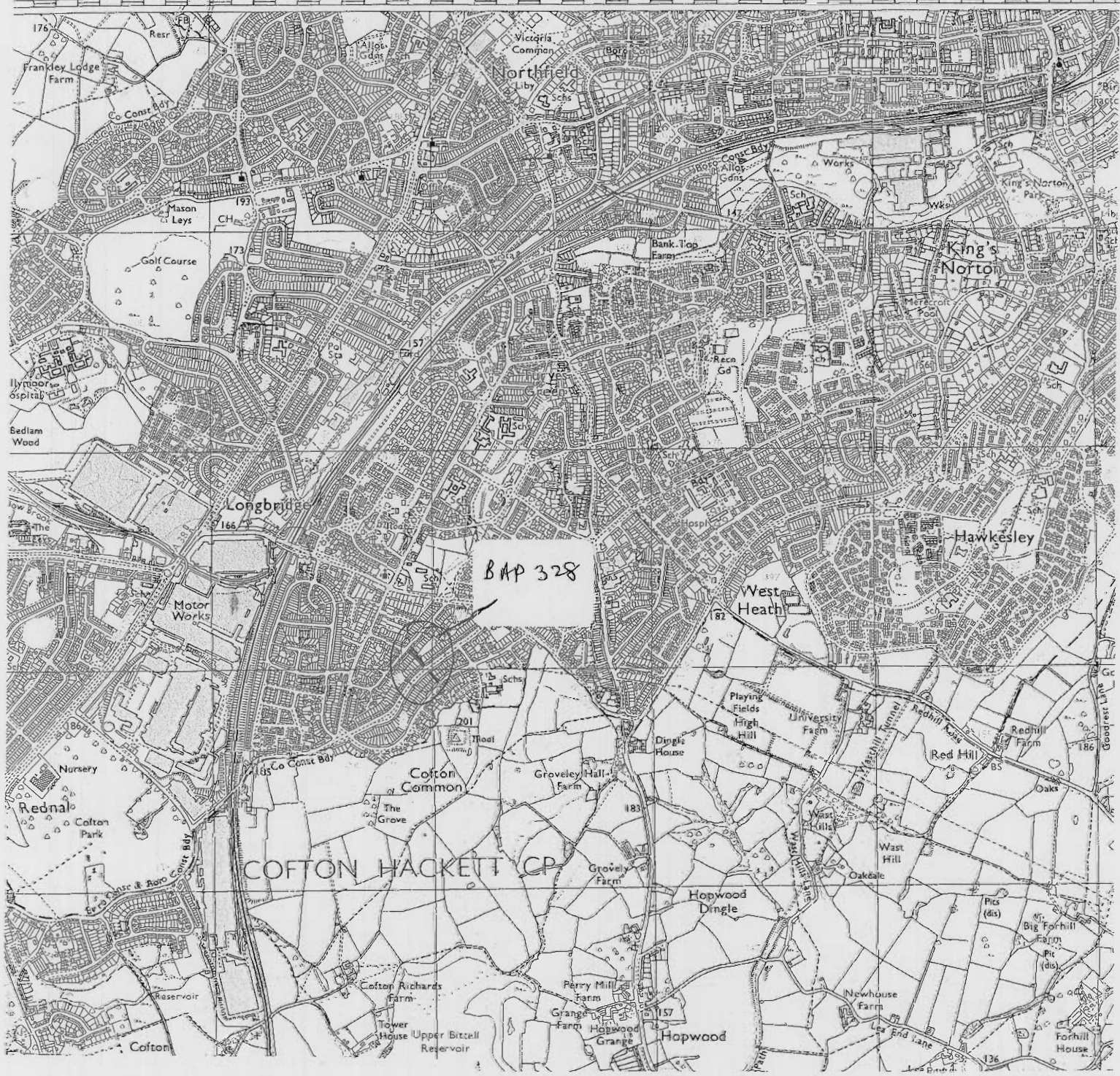

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 328

- 1 Both sections of this path are shown, in green, on the Ordnance Survey 'Pathfinder' map (sheet 954) of 1988, namely as a public footpath. This information will have been taken from the Worcestershire Definitive Map. This map was subsequently reviewed up to the present Local Authority boundary, when all the paths were renumbered.
- 2 Both sections of the path have a tarmac surface, with a 'no cycling' notice at Kingswood Road and a street light in each section.
- 3 Both parts are recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- 4 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the routes subsists as public footpaths and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
