

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 226

- 1 The path is first recorded on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- 2 The route is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- The original route is also shown, and labelled 'FP', on the Ordnance Survey 1/25,000 map sheet SP08 Birmingham (Central) (1952, 1970).
- 4 The Ordnance Survey 'Pathfinder' sheet 934 (1986) shows the north end of the path as having been diverted onto Nigel Avenue, although no Diversion Order has been located.
- 5 The path, according to a site visit, was considered to be a 'lovely urban footpath clearly used by pedestrians'.
- 6 The path is recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- 7 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
