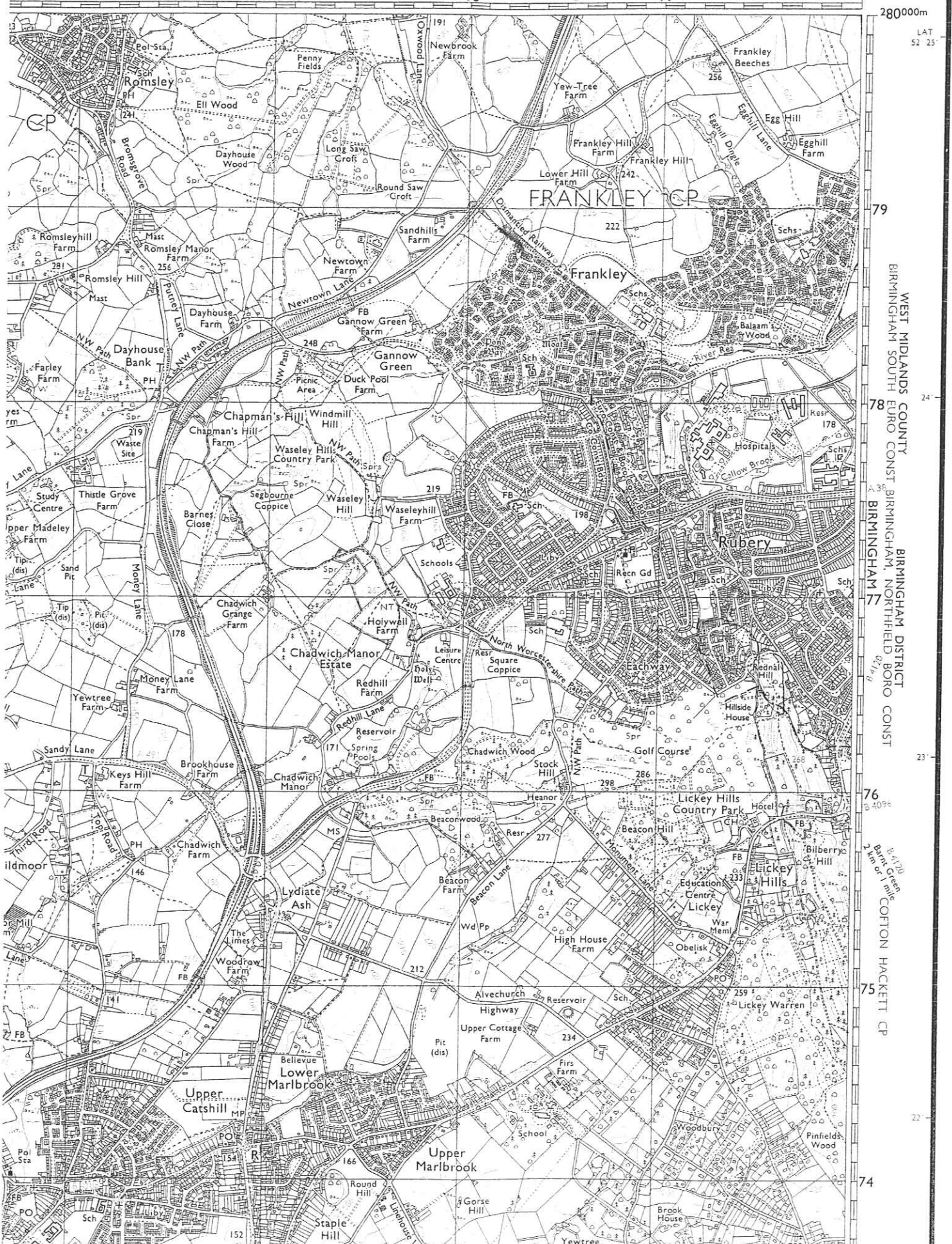

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 326

- 1 The path is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- 2 The path is presumed to have been diverted to pass over the M5 Motorway by the relevant Side Roads Order.
- 3 The path is recorded as a public footpath on the Ordnance Survey Pathfinder map, sheet 953, of 1991, the information having been taken from the relevant Definitive Map. The Worcestershire Definitive Map, however, was subsequently reviewed to the present Local Authority boundaries and, therefore, is not shown on the current 'Explorer' map.
- 4 The path starts on the City boundary at a metal stile and is unsurfaced. The originally recorded path stopped at another path (BAP 292) but now continues to Queen Elizabeth Road.
- 5 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
