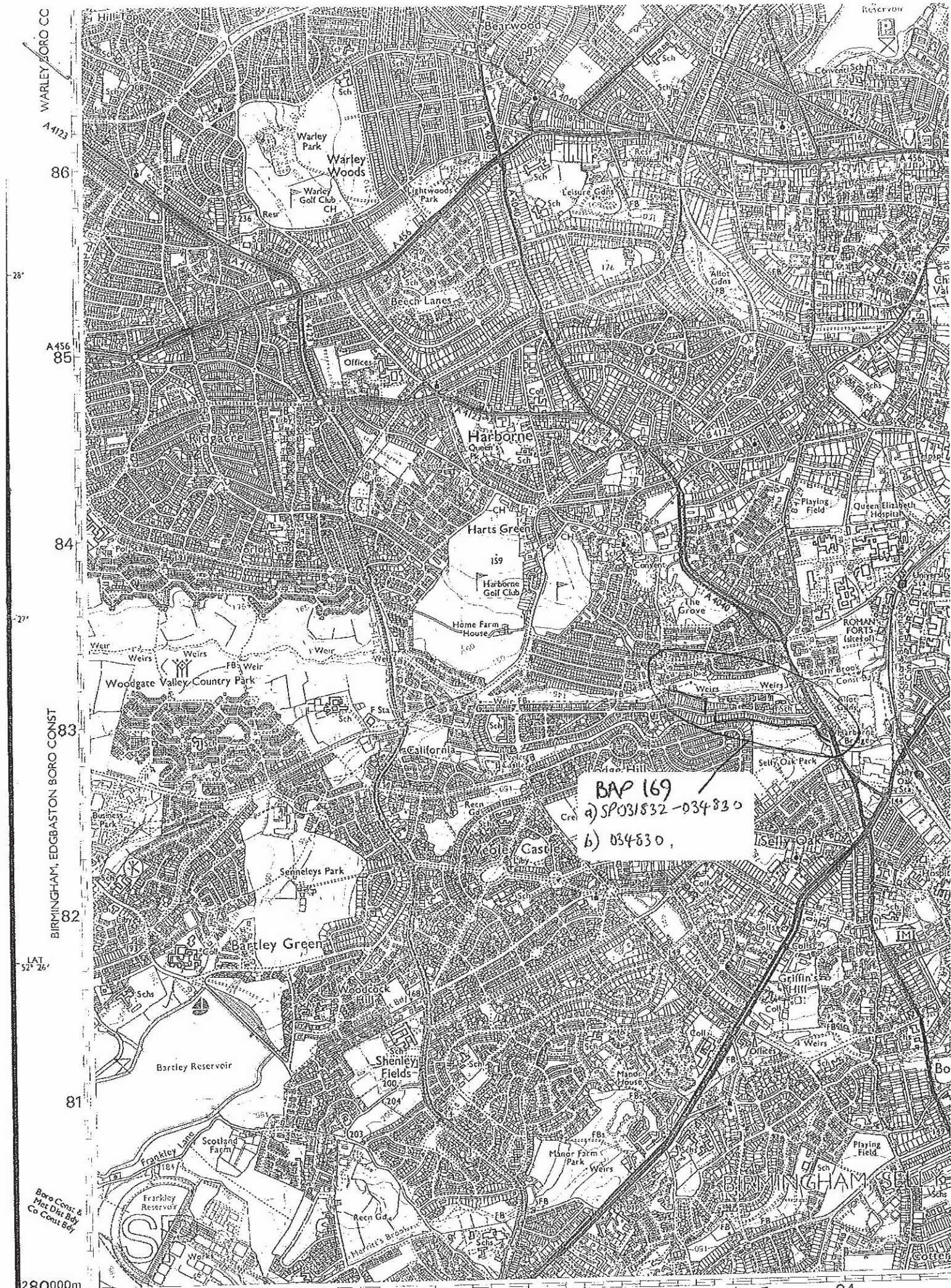

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 169

- 1 Part of this path is shown on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- 2 The path is shown, from Path Claim BAP 303, east and south to the canal, on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- 3 The section north from the canal was diverted on to two passageways either side of Reservoir Road by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order with a Certificate dated 16 August 1934. (Held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library, Archives section, at QS/B/21/2 (Box 15, item 6).)
- 4 The line of the old canal (from Harborne Lane) and a short section north from Reservoir Road, are recorded on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.
- 5 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
