Disability Awareness & Safeguarding Training Course for Private Hire Drivers

Disability Resource Centre provide a half day training course for private hire drivers applying for an operating licence from Birmingham City Council.

Attending the course and passing a short test at the end is a requirement of getting your licence from the Birmingham City Council.

Our courses usually take place weekly depending on demand from drivers. If you would like to attend our course, please contact us directly to book a place or send this form to us.

The cost of the course is £65 which must be paid on arrival. Payments can be made by either cash or card. You must pay the full amount and show us your photo-driving licence on the morning of the course when you sign in. Failure to bring valid ID or payment will mean you will have to rebook for a future date.

At the end of the course, there will be a short test based on the topics covered during the training. You must answer at least 8 out of 10 questions correctly to pass the course. Once you do, we will then notify the Birmingham City Council Licensing Department of all successful candidates.
